



Kivalliq Labour Market Needs Assessment

NVision Insight Group and Sakku Investments are conducting a labour market needs assessment in your community. The labour market needs assessment will be looking at the jobs available in the Kivalliq region and finding the best ways to connect Inuit people to these jobs. This includes asking what information employers need about the Kivalliq labour market, what employers are hiring, what jobs are available, how people find them and what education and training is required.

The final report will be a collection of responses from industry experts, employers and educators. It will also include a summary of past research about the Kivalliq job market.
