



Job Advertisement – Community Relations Manager (Permanent)

Nukik Corporation, an Inuit-owned company leading the development of the Kivalliq Hydro Fibre Link, has an opening for an experienced Manager of Community Relations to be based in the Kivalliq region of Nunavut. Nukik is a joint venture company owned by the Kivalliq Inuit Association (KIA) and Sakku Investments Corporation (Sakku).

Reporting to the Director of Business Development and Commercial Planning, the Manager of Community Relations will focus on keeping communities informed on project activities and acting as a bridge between local residents, businesses, and the project team. The incumbent will bring awareness to issues identified by community members and lead to their effective resolution. Work will be performed in Nunavut and Northern Manitoba and the project's success will require that all communities have the information they need to provide input into the design and development of the project.

Requirements

- Strong understanding of working with Inuit and Northern Manitoba Indigenous communities, local government, and local stakeholders.
- 10+ years of experience in a community relations, stakeholder engagement or strategic communications or relevant field related to major project delivery.
- University degree in Business Administration, Communications, Social Sciences or Political Science. Relevant professional experience may be considered in lieu of a degree.
- Bi-lingual in Inuktitut and English strongly preferred.
- Exceptional relationship, communication, facilitation, and interpersonal skills.
- Must demonstrate proficiency in Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Outlook).
- Excellent analytical, problem-solving, and decision-making skills.
- Exceptional leadership and management skills.
- Detail-oriented and persuasive.
- Equivalencies in combined education and experience will be considered.

Salary range would be \$100,000 to 160,000 per year (commensurate with experience) with a Nunavut Northern Allowance, and a Benefits package that includes medical, dental, and vision.
